Kaltura Connect on the Road virtual hub - Technical troubleshooting

Which browser do you recommend for accessing the event's content?

If you're watching from your computer, the latest versions of Chrome, Edge, Firefox, and Safari would all be ideal.

If you're joining from a mobile device or tablet, we recommend using Safari or Chrome.

Can I access Kaltura Connect on the Road virtual hub from my mobile?
